

Land to the east of 54 Daventry Road Norton Daventry NN112ND

To the Norton Parish Council

Date 21st July 2015.

The Norton Parish council really need to accept that the entire road, including grass verges, to the North of the main rd and east of 54 Daventry rd is classed as an unadopted Road

Maintenance of the Road lies with the properties with frontage to the Rd

54 Daventry rd is the only property with frontage, all other property owners who use it have a historic right to use the rd but they too could be asked to contribute to the maintenance.

We have been maintaining the rd since 1977 evidence is still visible today e.g. the curb stones edging the verge opposite 54.

The Northamptonshire County Council have also contributed to the maintenance purely on a voluntary basis. It dose not mean that it has been adopted or that they intend to adopt the rd.

Parish councils do not have the authority to adopt a private rd on behalf of the NCC

Parish councils cannot accept even as a gift a private rd, this also includes car parks, which they would be obliged to maintain and insure.

I will draw your attention to the rd sign in front of the old slaughter house. This sign was erected and is maintained by the Northamptonshire county council.

It reads [PRIVATE ROAD ACCESS ONLY]
